



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

DANGER - As with most electrical devices, electrical parts are electrically live even when the switch is off. To reduce the risk of electrocution, fire, or injury to persons: Check that the voltage of your electricity supply matches the voltage of your device. Any error when connecting the device can cause irreparable harm, not covered by the warranty.

WARNING - To reduce the risk of electrocution, fire, or injury to persons:

- Do not attempt to disassemble device.
 Unauthorized opening of the device automatically voids the warranty.
 Repairs must only be carried out by the authorized after-sales service.
- The device must be powered and charged by safety extra low voltage 5Vd.c., 1A.
- 3. This device contains a battery that is non-replaceable.
- 4. Frequently check condition of the USB cable & power supply. Discontinue use if any damage occurs. Never operate this device if it has a damaged cord or plug, or if it has been dropped, damaged, or fully immersed into water. Contact the after-sales service if this occurs.
- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces. Do not wrap the cord around the device.

- 6. In case of unusual smell or sound, stop use immediately, disconnect power supply, turn off the device by leaving it untouched until power turns off & contact our after-sales service.
- Using the device on other areas of the body than hair has not been tested and the risks are unknown.
- Clean device only in recommended manner. Alternative cleaning method may damage the material & system.
 Do not clean with abrasive or corrosive products.
- Never drop or insert any object other than authorized cartridges into any opening.
- 10. For Household Use Only.
 - To dispose of the device, please contact and use an appropriate e-waste facility.
 - Do not attempt to disassemble or remove the battery.

- Do not expose device to fire or excessive temperature. Keep away from heat source and high temperature (direct sunlight, radiator, heater). Exposure to fire or temperature above 130°C may cause explosion.
- 12. Do not use this device near bathtubs, shower, basins or vessels containing water. Do not leave device plugged in proximity of water. Do not get the wall adaptor or USB cable wet. Do not place or store device where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- 13. Do not use while bathing.
- 14. If water gets into inner part of the device, unplug the power supply immediately, turn off the device by leaving it untouched until power turns off & contact our after-sales service. Do not attempt to switch the device back on due to electrical injury risk.

- 21. Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, or if it has been dropped, damaged, or dropped into water. Return the appliance to a service center for examination and repair.
- 22. Never use while sleeping.
- 23. Never drop or insert any object into any opening or hose.
- 24. Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.



NEW CARTRIDGE

- Insert the new color cartridge into the device.
- Push the power button to start the device. The checkmark will appear in solid orange, indicating the device + color cartridge is ready for warm-up.
- Hold the power button until the warmup sequence starts. The checkmark will start pulsing orange. This sequence will last up to 20 seconds.

Note: It is important to keep the device in an upward angle, from 30 degrees to straight up, to ensure a successful warm-up. If this angle is not maintained, the device will pause until the orientation is facing upward. During this sequence, formula may be dispensed - do not apply it on your hair or skin.




- Once the warm-up sequence is completed, the checkmark will change to solid green, indicating the device + color cartridge is ready for dispensing.
- 5. Press the power button again to start dispensing on your hair.

CLEANING BETWEEN HAIR COLORATION

The device must be cleaned after every use with the reusable cleaning cartridge provided.

- Fill the cleaning cartridge with LUKEWARM water to the fill line and securely close.
- Insert the cleaning cartridge into the device - the checkmark will appear solid blue.
- 3. Position the device above the sink.
- Hold the power button until the cleaning sequence starts. This will last up to two minutes - the checkmark will pulse blue.


Note: It is important to keep the device in a downward angle to ensure successful cleaning. If this angle is not maintained, the device will pause until the orientation is corrected.



- Tilt the device downward towards the sink when cleaning for better water flow.
- Allow device to complete its autocleaning until the end (cleaning cartridge should be completely emptied).
- Eject the cleaning cartridge and check if all the water has been used. If not, restart the cleaning sequence from step (2) until the cleaning cartridge is emptied.

FILL LEVEL INDICATOR

Upon inserting the formula cartridge into device, fill indicator LEDs will light from bottom to top representing the level of liquid in your cartridge(s).



CHARGING

Before first use, please charge your device. Allow approximately 2 hours for a full charge. A fully charged device lasts for a maximum of 3 formula cartridges.

Charging the device

Your device is rechargeable, USB-C charging cable included. Insert the cable into the USB-C charging port on the device and charge using a USB power adapter. Battery symbol will flash indicating charging. See chart on next page.
